

1500 parking spaces in Helsingør - free of charge

Parking in Helsingør

The centre of Helsingør is a beautifully preserved area with narrow streets. Some of these are pedestrian streets, others are one-way streets with parking allowed in one side of the road. In order to reduce the amount of traffic in the inner city, Helsingør County Council advises vehicle drivers to primarily use the parking spaces in the outskirts of town.

Remember your parking disc

Parking in Helsingør town centre is restricted to one hour. In pedestrian streets with full vehicle thoroughfare, parking is only allowed in designated areas. Some larger parking lots carry a three-hour limit while others allow 24-hour parking. Maximum limits are displayed at entrances to car parks. One and three-hour limits are effective between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on weekdays and between 8 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Saturdays. Parking discs must be displayed. They are available at Parkingservice, Helsingør Tourist Office, petrol stations and several shops in town.

Multi-storey Car Park

Twelve-hour parking is permitted on the 8th and 9th floors of the multi-storey car park near Trækbanen. Three-hour parking

is effective on all other floors. The car park is closed at night, apart from floors 0 and +1.

Opening hours:

Monday-Friday: 6 a.m. - 9 p.m. Saturdays: 6 a.m. - 6 p.m. The car park is closed until Monday morning Public holidays: Closed

Special permits are available for night-time parking on floors +2 - +9. An annual permit costs DKK 1.300 and a six-month permit costs DKK 800. Further information is available from the Municipal Parking Authority (Tel: +45 49 28 20 01) or the Helsingør City Centre Estate Inspectorate

(Tel: +45 49 26 10 60). Maximum vehicle height throughout the multi-storey car park is 2.05m and parking is free during opening hours.


Bus, train or bicycle

Buses, trains or bicycles are good alternatives to cars for those visiting Helsingør. There's always a parking space close by for your bicycle, which is both a healthy and environmental friendly method of transport. The bus terminus is to be found directly opposite the train station, with public transport buses to all corners of the county and beyond. Helsingør main train station is the head of the line, with connections to Copenhagen, Hillerød, Hornbæk and Gilleleje.
